You will have the opportunity to meet the staff, tour the site and find out what it's like to be part of our wonderful school.



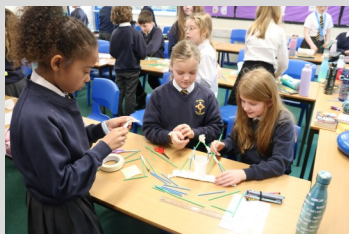
