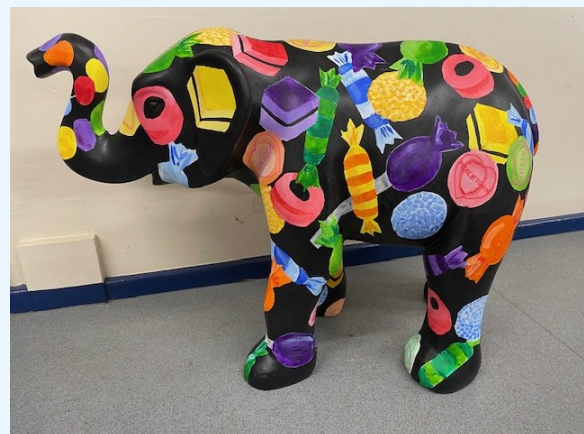
We have large containers full of school uniform, shoes, trainers, water bottles, lunch boxes etc. We would much rather these items went to a good home than ended up in the bin.
